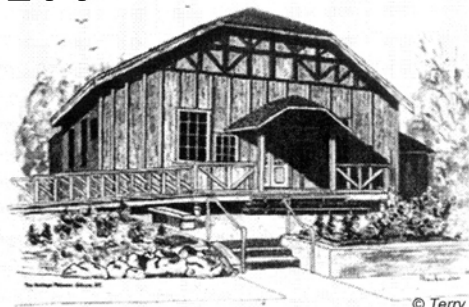

10 years ago the first play was 'Arsenic and Old Lace'. It opened in July 2000, and the audience kept cool by fanning themselves with their programmes. This spurred us on to obtain grant money for air conditioning. 10 years ago we started off with a small upright piano. Now we have progressed to a full size concert grand. Over the past 10 years we have upgraded the sound and lighting equipment and we thank local government, service clubs, societies, individuals and local businesses.

Things have changed, we think for the better. In the beginning directors vacuumed, cleaned the toilets, weeded and dealt with the day-to-day management of the Playhouse. We also had a great deal of volunteer help and continue to have a solid and loyal volunteer base. We have done our utmost to be fiscally responsible and now have a manager and a janitor and the Gibsons Garden Club does a voluntary fantastic job of keeping the grounds beautiful.

This year we hope to improve access to the parking lot and improve exterior lighting. The Playhouse is used for such things as drama, film, dance, music as well as seminars and the annual Elves Telethon. True community participation!

We keep the rental prices as low as we possibly can, always remembering we have to pay our bills, because our mission is to serve the community. Every July we do our annual fundraiser, SOPA, and this year will be the 9th annual Showcase of Performing Arts.

I've tried not to mention individual names tonight because I'm bound to make a blunder....but all of you who are here were invited because of what you have done to make an idea become a reality. On behalf of the Gibsons Landing Heritage Society I would like to thank you, the community, for having such trust in us and for making our dreams come true.
